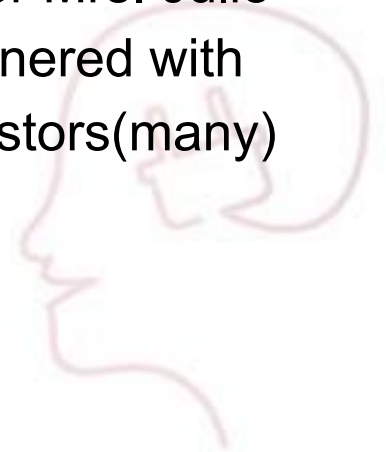

Our Community: Supportive Partnerships

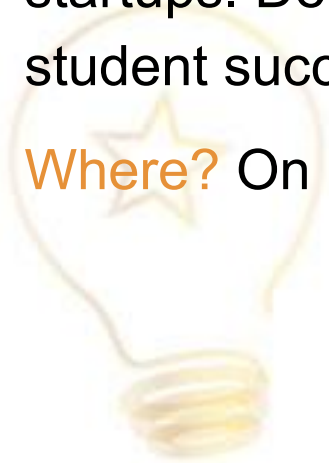
